“Peacock” Stroller Blanket

APPROXIMATE SIZE: 24” X 34”



Materials:

- Approx. 150 yards of a dark green Aran (4) weight yarn
- Approx. 150 yards of a navy blue Aran (4) weight yarn
- Approx. 300 of a light purple Aran (4) weight yarn
- US size 8 circular needles – minimum 29” *(only for holding the blanket as you will be knitting this piece flat and turning your work)*
- Darning needle for weaving in the ends

Directions:

Cast on 110 stitches with the dark green yarn.

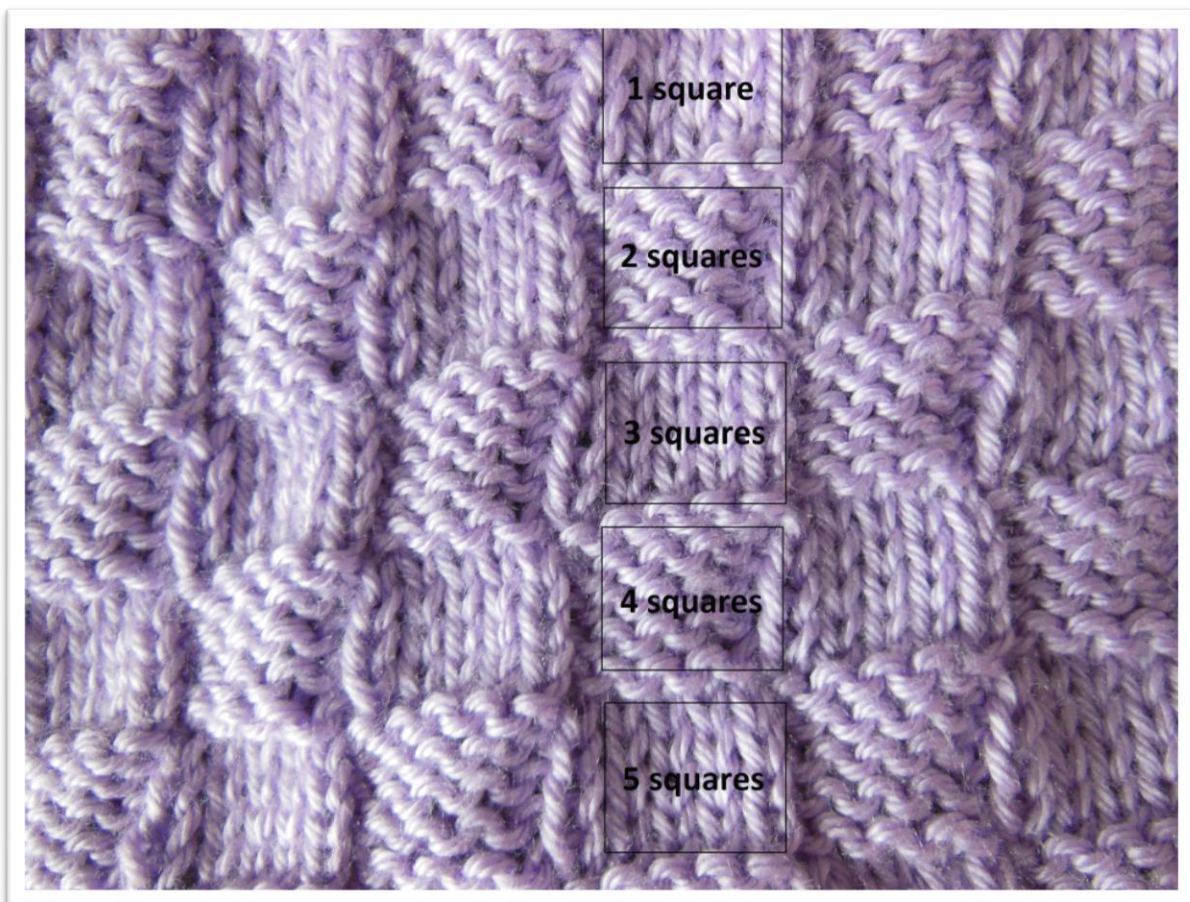
Rows 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 - Knit 5, Purl 5, Knit 5, Purl 5 across the row

Rows 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 - Purl 5, Knit 5, Purl 5, Knit 5 across the row.

Repeat above rows 1 - 10 to create the "Basket Weave" pattern.

NOTE: Always change your yarn colour on the same side and at the completion of row 10.

Once you have 10 "squares" with the green yarn (*see photo below showing how to count squares*), and have *completed row 10 of the pattern*, switch to your blue yarn.



Beginning on Row 1, follow the above Basket Weave pattern until you have 10 "squares" with the blue yarn. Again, make sure you have ended on row 10.

Now change to your light purple yarn.

Beginning on Row 1, continue to follow the above pattern until you have **20** “squares” with your light purple yarn.

Cast off on row 10 of the pattern.

With your darning needle, weave in your ends.
