

Pear tree Knitting

For the love of all things cozy!!

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Bi-Colour Dish Cloth 8" X 8"



Materials:

- 2 colours (A & B) of Aran weight 100% **cotton** yarn - approximately 50 yards of colour A (*main colour*) and 25 yards of colour B (*neutral colour*)
- US size 6 needles
- Darning needle for weaving in the ends

The amount of yarn used for this pattern is only estimated. Multiple projects have been created from larger balls of yarn therefore making it difficult to be exact. It's recommended you start each project with more yarn than what the pattern calls for.

Directions:

Cast on 49 stitches using **colour A** (*main colour*).

Do not cut your yarn at the end of the rows. Carry it up the sides as you work.

Row 1 – knit every stitch with colour A

Row 2 – knit every stitch with colour A

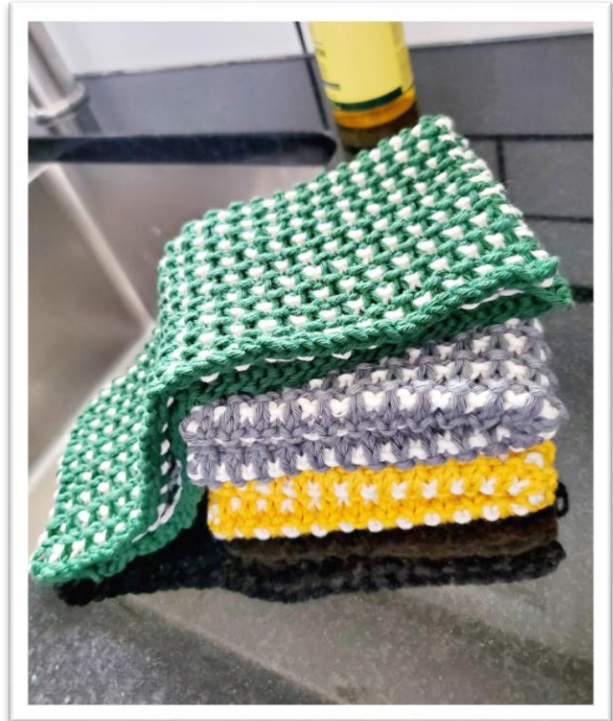
Row 3 – using **colour B** (*neutral colour*), knit 1, *slip 1 purl wise, knit 1* repeat from * to * across row

Row 4 – using **colour B**, knit 1, *yarn forward, slip 1 purl wise, yarn back, knit 1* repeat from * to * across the row

Repeat rows 1 - 4 above until your piece measures 8" in *total* ending on Row 1.

Cast off in pattern on Row 2 then weave in your ends.

It's recommended you wash your dish cloth before the first use as this makes it more absorbent.



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
