

Peartree Knitting

For the love of all things cozy!!

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Classic 2-Tone Baby Blanket
(Approx. 28" X 38")



Materials:

- Approx. 320 yards of a dark yellow yarn – DK weight (2 balls of approx. 160 yards each)
- Approx. 960 yards of a light yellow yarn – DK weight (2 balls of approx. 480 yards each)
- Size 10 US needles
- Darning needle for weaving in the ends

NOTES:

- **This blanket is double knit using 2 strands of yarn at one time.**
- **I used Stylecraft Special DK yarn for this blanket.**

Gauge:

Approx. 14 stitches x 28 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch

Directions:

BORDER:

Cast on 100 stitches with 2 strands of the **dark yellow** yarn held together.

Knit every row (Garter stitch) for 20 rows (approx. 3") **ending on the opposite side** of your cast on tail.


BODY PATTERN:

Once the border is complete, you will start on the body of your blanket.

ROW 1: Knit 12 stitches, purl 76 stitches, knit the last 12 stitches

ROW 2: Knit every stitch

Repeat the above 2 rows until your piece is about 10" in **total**.




When the dark yellow section is about 10", switch to the light yellow yarn. **Change the colour on the same side as your cast on tail.**

Continue with the above 2 rows of the body pattern until your ***entire piece is 35" in total.***

Once your blanket is 35" in total, knit every row for 19 rows (approx. 3") to create your bottom border.

Cast off on the next row (row 20), then weave in all your ends.



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
